

## 1. Etosha Tour

Day 1: Early rise from Ozonduno, drive to north, passing Tsumeb to Mushara Lodge which is situated east from Etosha National Park. On request we can stop in Tsumeb to visit the museum and do a town cruise to see where Namibia's Copper mine is. Continue the drive to the Otjikoto Lake and enjoy the view. Final destination for the day is then Mushara Lodge where we will overnight, have lunch and a little rest. In the afternoon we shall drive into the Etosha Park till sunset.

Day 2: After breakfast route takes us via drive through Namutoni and Halali rest camps in Etosha, to Okaukuejo bungalow (B+B). On our way we will stop at numerous waterholes. Lunch can be enjoyed at Halali (at own cost). Dinner (at own cost) will be enjoyed in Okaukuejo Restaurant and after dinner we can watch Elephants, rhino's and lions at the waterhole.

Day 3: After breakfast we leave Etosha for Windhoek. We can stop at Okahandja, which is on our way to Windhoek, for some souvenir shopping at the woodcarving market. In Windhoek we shall do a city tour and after lunch (at own cost) we drive to our lodge outside of Windhoek, from where you can enjoy the wonderful wildlife of Namibia for the last time before leaving for home.

Day 4: Depending on departure time, we either go for a last shopping spree in Windhoek, or we leave for the airport.
